1.Scope of the release

The objective of this document is to list the changes, modifications, decommissions, bug corrections that are part of the XMA release **23.0** This contains RMA (Role Management Application), SMA (Self-Management Application) and HMA (Helpdesk Management Application).

Timing

- Release on the INT environment: on Thursday, the **23rd of March 2023**
- Release on the PROD environment will be on Thursday, the **13st of April 2023**
- An additional release, if necessary, on the PROD environment will be on Thursday, the **20th of April 2023** or on Tuesday, the **25th of April 2023**

The main changes of this release are:

- **Incidents resolution:**
 - RMA
 - Adjusting expiration date of Active Roles
 - Possibility to temporally suspend selected Active Roles.
 - Possibility to directly assign a role for an existing employee.
 - Failing login into RMA (RMA_ERR_3204 and RMA_ERR_2420) works again.
 - Adding additional fields (columns) when Exporting roles
 - SMA
 - Optimisation of error messages when not filling in required fields. (Postal Code/Country Code/...)
 - Removing Security code "MAIL OTP" in your profile. (Error 405)
 - Optimisation on retrieving the correct code of birth country.
 - Optimisation of error messages when changing password.
 - HMA
 - Possibility to sort on all possible fields (searched results)
 - Optimisation when registering a new profile.
 - Update on content for specific eIDAS users
- **Security and Accessibility Improvements**
 - Various improvements (backend) on error messages
- **Technical Improvements**
 - Various improvements (backend)
